- During Covid19 there has been a huge push getting worship services online. This has created an opportunity for many unbelievers to be reached for the Gospel. He encourages the church to get outside the church during Covid and reach people instead of being frustrated about not being able to use the church building. There is an opportunity to reach people during the crisis.
- Barry is also involved at the Angola prison in Missouri. He teaches a Bible class where people can then join a Bible college. He also teaches the Bible college graduates in further education.
